Itinerary:

Day 01: Cape Town - Optional Half day City Tour

Welcome to Cape Town. After clearing customs, meet our representative in the waiting area and transfer to your hotel. In the afternoon, go for an optional half day city tour on a private / SIC basis. This tour gives you the opportunity to discover the spirit of the Mother City, experience her vibrant cultures and history and enjoy botanical scenery. The tour leaves at 8 am in the morning and 2 pm in the afternoon. It is for 4 hours.

Highlights of the tour include: Table Mountain - weather permitting, scenic coastal drive through Clifton & Sea Point, Green Market Square, District Six, and Walk through the Company Gardens, Scenic City tour passing the Houses of Parliament, the City Hall, the Castle and Slave lodge. Visit to Table Mountain (weather permitting)

Overnight at your hotel in Cape Town.

Day 02: Full day Cape Peninsula / Cape Point Tour

After breakfast today at 9 am, depart for a full day Cape Peninsula / Cape Point tour. Embark on Africa's premier tour route to the romantic meeting place of the Indian & Atlantic Oceans. Sir Francis Drake the explorer called it "the fairest Cape that we saw in the circumference of the Globe" This tour offers a full and exciting day out. The tour departs at 9 am and you come back generally by 5 pm.

Includes: Hout Bay, 30-minute cruise to the seal colony in a glass bottom boat (weather permitting), Cape Point nature reserve, Cape Point, Cape of Good Hope, stop for lunch at Fish Hoek Galley (included, visit penguin colony in Simonstown and Kirstenbosch botanical gardens.

In the evening return to your hotel. Overnight at hotel in Cape Town.

Day 03: Knysna, Sunset lagoon Cruise

After an early breakfast today, depart to Knysna on the Garden Route. It is a seven hours scenic drive. Lunch is en-route on own. Reach Knysna and relax at your hotel after check in.

In the evening at 16:00 hrs. (winter) or 17:15 hrs. (summer), enjoy a beautiful Sunset cruise on the marvellous Knysna Lagoon. A visit to Knysna would be incomplete without a trip to the heads - a striking geological feature made up of a pair of huge, brightly coloured cliffs lying at the mouth of the lagoon, flanking a channel of potentially treacherous water that flows into Knysna's lagoon. You can cruise on the 3 leg river cat boat for this or on the John Ben.

Overnight at your hotel in Knysna.

Day 04: Knysna - Oudtshoorn, Full day excursion at Oudtshoorn

After breakfast today, depart to Oudtshoorn which is just 91 miles away from Knysna. It's a scenic drive. You have a full day of activities today at Oudtshoorn. Oudtshoorn is an important point on the Garden Route.

Today you will indulge in the following activities:-

Ostrich Farm - During your visit experience the world's largest bird which lays the largest egg, has the most beautiful feathers and eyes that make you want to fall in love and hug them. You can enjoy riding the birds at your own risk, stand on their eggs, touch the birds and cuddle the chicks. Professional multilingual guides take you on a conducted tour where you will learn about the birds, experience laughter & beauty situated in a valley surrounded by thousands of ostriches and majestic mountains. Enjoy lunch at this ostrich farm

Cango Caves - The Klein Karoo's oldest and most popular attraction ... one of the world's natural wonders.

Cango Wildlife Ranch - here you will have the opportunity to view some of the animal species which inhabited the Karoo region in the early days.

Late in the evening, return back to your hotel in Knysna. Overnight at your hotel in Knysna.

Day 05: Knysna - George - Johannesburg - Sun City

After an early breakfast, depart to Johannesburg via flight from George Airport (44 miles from Knysna approximately) and from there transfer to Sun City which is a pleasant 2.5 hour drive from the Johannesburg airport. Sun City is internationally renowned as Africa's premier holiday resort, offering a myriad of different entertainment and relaxation opportunities as well as enough attractions and activities to keep everyone busy.

The fabulous Sun City resort complex captivates visitors with its combination of golf, game-viewing and gambling as well as world-class hotels. Formerly the gambling Mecca of South Africa, Sun City still attracts those who wish to gamble but also those who want to relax.

Overnight at your hotel in Sun City.

Day 06: Game Drive at Pilanesburg National Park, Visit to Valley of the Waves

Early Morning, indulge in a game drive at the beautiful Pilanesburg National Park for 2 and half hours. This is a malaria free zone and hence no yellow fever vaccination is required. Come back and have breakfast.

Home to at least 7000 animals including 24 major species and the BIG FIVE, Pilanesburg National park is a must for everyone.

Later explore Sun City including the valley of waves. The Valley of Waves is the central feature of the Lost City at Sun City. It is one of the most advanced water parks in the world, dominated by the Roaring Lagoon, a 6 500-square metre (7560-square yards) wave pool with a palm-fringed beach. Hydraulic mechanisms can generate a 1, 8 metre (6 feet 8 inches) wave every 90 seconds. When waves are not generated, a bobbing cycle is generated in a diamond pattern. The valley of waves is open from 10 am to 5 pm on a daily basis.

Overnight at your hotel in Sun City.

Day 07: Flight from Johannesburg to back home

After breakfast, bid farewell to Sun City and transfer to Johannesburg to catch your flight home.

Points to Note (If any)

Your Health: It is your (Traveller's) responsibility to ensure that you are in good health and medically fit to undertake safari tour. Foreign currency can be exchanged at local banks and Bureaux de Change. ATM's are readily available in major cities.

Helpful items for your packing list:

- Light weight shirts/blouses with long sleeves as protection from the sun and mosquitos
- T-shirts / Shorts / Jeans or safari trousers / Pajamas / Socks /Underwear
- A light weight water-proof jacket
- Comfortable walking shoes/sneakers / Comfortable walking sandals or flip flops for warmer days
- A wide brimmed hat with under-chin tie to prevent it from flying away
- Swimsuit
- A warm windproof jacket (winter) / A fleece jacket that will go under the warm jacket (winter) /A warm polo neck shirt (winter) A beanie (winter)
- Gloves (winter) / A warm scarf (winter)
- Sunglasses / Spare prescription eye glasses/contact lenses
- Binoculars
- Cameras and related paraphernalia like lenses etc and plenty of memory cards and

spare batteries

- A small powerful flashlight and extra batteries
- Travel alarm clock / Small purse size umbrella can come in handy
- Small lint roller / A light packable backpack or tote to carry equipment and stuff on game vehicles
- A supply of Ziploc bags in different sizes may come in handy for dust or water proofing cameras, wet bathing suits etc.
- Chargers for cell phones, iPads, cameras, computers and you may want to invest in a mini travel charger surge protector with dual USB ports and five charging outlets.

Photography: Due to nature of the safari tour, rugged terrain and extremely dusty conditions,

We would like to urge to carefully pack all sensitive photographic, electronic and filming equipment, preferably in the dust-proof bags.

People: South Africans are loud and friendly – genuinely friendly. They’re the ones who will strike up a conversation with the locals in any country they visit. And whenever they come across tourists on their own turf, they’re equally as warm-hearted.

Population can be divided into (at least) 11 ethnic groups, the biggest group of which is the Zulu, probably found everywhere in the country. South Africa has 11 officially recognized languages, most of them indigenous dialects.

English is widely spoken throughout and is the primary language in cities, commerce, banking, and government. Road signs and official forms are in English and you can expect all hotel staff to speak it fluently.

Climate: South Africa enjoys a high number of clear, sunny days. Although varied through different regions, South Africa’s climate is generally mild year-round.

Snowfall is limited to the highest mountain peaks and mean annual rainfall comes to a relatively dry 20 inches.

CAPE TOWN has a Mediterranean climate – it rains during the winter months and it is chilly. The summer months are dry and warm and can be very windy at times.

DURBAN’S climate is almost the same as Miami Florida, hot and humid and rainy in the summer, warm dry days and cool to chilly evenings during the winter months.

JOHANNESBURG’S climate is warm during the summer with most of the rainfall during this time. Because of the heat in Johannesburg in the summer, residents and visitors alike can experience the most spectacular thunder and lightning storms! Winters in Johannesburg are moderate, with dry sunny days and chilly nights.

KRUGER NATIONAL PARK – climate during the summertime is hot and humid during the day and cooler in the evenings. Afternoons very often bring thundershowers which tend to refresh the air considerably. Winter weather is warm and dry during the days with chilly evenings and mornings.

Make no mistake, in the winter months the evenings and early mornings can be bitterly cold. If you are on safari during this time, you will need to take very warm clothing especially for early morning game drives.

Safety and Security: Leaving your belongings unattended is not advisable. Be with your driver / guide and/or group to avoid unnecessary issues.

Staying safe on Wildlife Viewing Activities: Your safari guide will ensure your safety at all times - listen carefully to instructions and follow the park's rules at all times. When on a self-drive safari, don't drive too close to wildlife and only leave your car in designated areas where it is safe to do so.

Staying safe in Cities and Towns: South Africa has a high level of crime, including rape and murder. The risk of violent crime to visitors travelling to the main tourist destinations is generally low. The South African authorities prioritise protecting tourists and tourism police are deployed in several towns and cities. Being in numbers and staying with your driver / guide always helps. It may not be safe to venture out post dark alone.
